Dear Parents / Carers

Electronic Devices / Mobile Telephones

I understand that electronic equipment is part of modern life and mobile telephones, in particular, have many benefits. Recently, however, we are finding increasing numbers of KS2 pupils bringing mobile phones etc into school.

I understand that parents / carers may need the added security of a mobile telephone for pupils who use public transport or walk to school independently. Therefore we are limiting authorisation of mobile telephones in school to pupils under such, or exceptional, circumstances.

All electronic devices must be handed to the class teacher at the start of the school day and collected at the end of the school day. The school does not accept liability for loss or damage of any electronic device held in the schools possession. If a mobile telephone is brought onto the school premises without prior authorisation it will be confiscated and held in the school office. Collection of this item can only be by the parent / carer.
