Our skills this week are:

- Use fronted adverbials e.g. Later that day, I heard the bad news.
- Use commas after fronted adverbials

Compulsory Writing Tasks:

- **Purple Mash Task 1:** Log on to Purple Mash and complete your 'Fronted Adverbials' 2Do. Each sentence has been taken from the 'King of the Fishes' story but has had its fronted adverbial removed. Use the word bank to help you put in your own fronted adverbials to create a sentence which makes sense. Remember to use a comma after every fronted adverbial.
- **Purple Mash Task 2:** The paragraph in the attached document describes Li's journey back to the sea to make his wish. Re-write the paragraph in your own words using fronted adverbials. There are some questions for you to consider when writing your own paragraph.
