Computing – Coding and Animations:

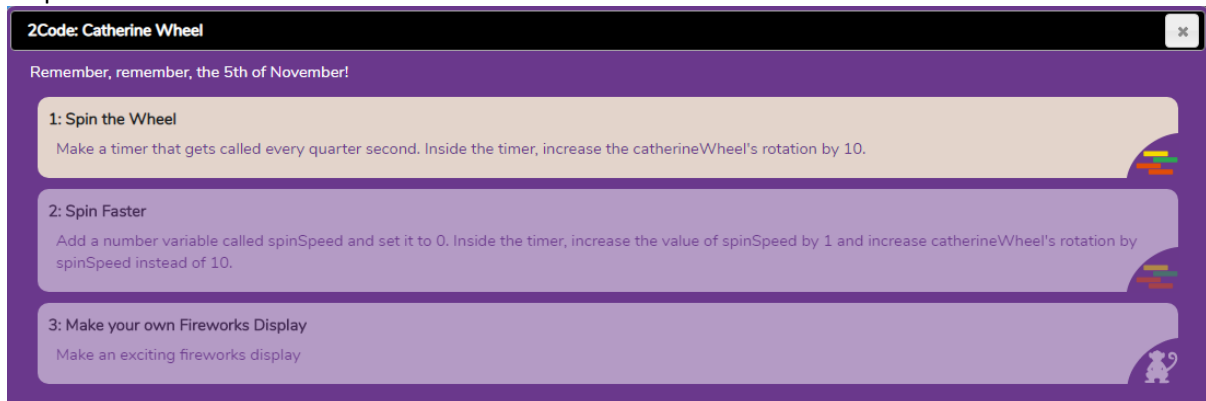
This week in computing, we are looking at coding and animations. Click the link below to find out how we get computers to do what we want. Read the information and watch the two videos.
