English – Must do

Our skill this week is: Adverbs

Compulsory Writing Tasks:

Purple Mash Task 1: Sentences with Adverbs

Log on to Purple Mash and complete your 2do – Sentences with Adverbs. You are going to write your own sentences including the adverbs you found in the story, from the word mat below or ones you have thought of yourself. The sentences don't have to be related to the story but they can be if you like.

Purple Mash Task 2: My Elf Story

Log on to Purple Mash to complete your 2do – My Elf Story. You are going to write a story about some elves that help people. Remember to write a clear beginning, middle and end. Try and use as many interesting adverbs in your story as you can.

Geography
