



Permission for walking home alone

Our school policy for Key Stage 2 is at the end of the day, the class teacher will walk the children to meet their parents or another named adult on the lower playground. If the person that is collecting them is not there, they must wait at the school office. If it is the agreed routine for the family that the child is to walk home independently then they will be allowed to do so (*the definition of walking home is the child leaving the school premises independently*).

Please note the class teacher will not sign the child out at the end of the school day. However, if you have stated that under no circumstances should your child leave the premises independently, we will ensure that does not happen.

If you feel your child is mature enough to cope with this responsibility of leaving the premises independently or walking home, would you please complete and return the slip below, stating if you give permission or not for your child to do so.
