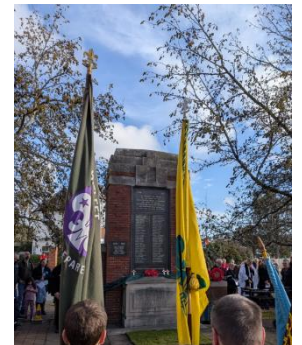
What a wonderful, full week it has been.
