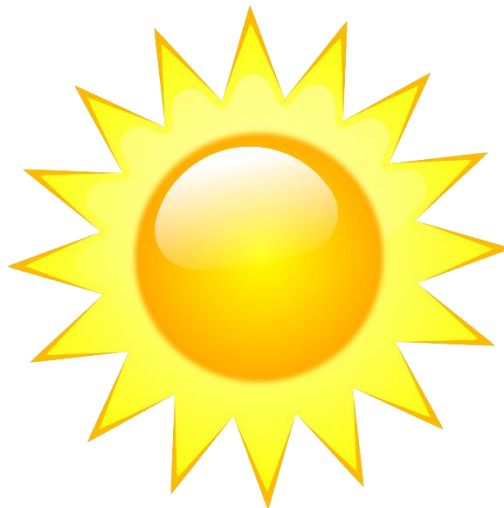
Dear St Mary's families,

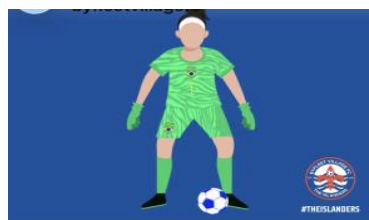
